# NORTH SURREY SKATING CLUB RULES & DATES TO REMEMBER - SPRING 2017

### \*\*PARENTS, PLEASE TAKE THE TIME TO REVIEW THIS WITH YOUR CHILD\*\*

Welcome to the North Surrey Skating Club Spring Session. Please ensure that you and your child are familiar with the Club Rules, Dress Code and Buy-on requirements. In addition, please make careful note of the Dates to Remember, as this includes information on Upcoming Events and Cancellations for the Spring Session.

### **GENERAL RULES:**

- 1. The soloist has the complete right of way, followed by lesson skaters. Other skaters MUST give way.
- 2. All skating must be of the type scheduled i.e. Dancing on Dance session.
- 3. NO MP3 PLAYERS OR CELL PHONES are allowed on the ice. These pose a risk to other skaters.
- 4. Solo music is played in order. If you refuse your music, your name goes to the bottom of the list.
- 5. Only solo's requested by a coach will be played out of order. Skaters are not to request their music; it will be played in order.
- 6. In club and out of club buy-ons will be played once all other skaters' solos have been played.
- 7. Do not put others at risk by standing around or playing on the ice. Be aware of fast moving sessions.
- 8. No hockey skates allowed except on CANSKATE ice.
- 9. Spectators are <u>NOT ALLOWED</u> to coach, teach or lecture at the rink boards or they will be asked to leave the arena. Interrupting a moving session is a hazard. Spectators should remain in the stands.
- 10. Once the session has begun the gate will be closed, skaters are expected to remain on the ice for the full session.
- 11. Absence from a regular session that has been purchased does not allow you to "make up" the session at another time unless it has been approved by the board.
- 12. Skaters must have turned in their registration papers before going on the ice.
- 13. CANSKATERS must wear an ice approved hockey helmet (no bike helmets allowed).

### DRESS CODE:

Hair **MUST** be tied back. Girls must wear skating dresses, skating skirts, or straight-legged skating pants. Boys must wear skating pants or straight-legged track pants with hooks. **NO JEANS, SHORTS OR BARE MIDRIFFS ALLOWED.** 

# **BUY-ONS**:

- 1. <u>ALL</u> buy-ons <u>MUST</u> report to the music player and pay for the session before going on the ice. THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS. The entire time allocated for the session must be purchased.
  - Example: If you only wish to skate a portion of a 1 hour session, you must still pay for the entire hour.
- 2. Prices for buy-ons are included on the front cover. Buy-on skaters will have their music played once all other skaters' music has been played.
- 3. Only sessions that say OPEN are available for in club and out of club buy-ons, unless the skater is also registered in one of the programs.
  - Example: An in club skater in the Silver Program buying Silver Freeskate ice.
